

Four Phase Step-by-Step Proven Process

- Bring residents together
- Identify and honor the unique character of our City
- Promote the emotional connection of the people who live here

Instead of Hosting Meetings

Meet residents where they already are:

- community events, neighborhood parties,
- schools,
- businesses, and
- other gatherings.



Finding our shared values.

Phase 1 *IMAGINE*2-3 months



- Understand who lives, works and plays in Shawnee and how best to reach them
- Tap into local knowledge
- Engage via established networks

Phase 2 CONNECT 6-8 months

- Gather stories
- Find common ground
- Reflect on observations



A different but complimentary plan to our other efforts.

Phase 3 PLAN 4-6 months

- Reflect on what matters
- Generate actionable data points
- Plan for the short- and long-term
- Aim for broad and meaningful participation



Phase 4 ACT Ongoing



- Incorporate this data into other planning processes.
- Continue interacting with community partners.
- Apply the values we discovered.
- Celebrate our success.


